## Language & Literacy

### **Talking & Listening:**



\*Talk to your child about their day and ask questions about what they have learnt.

### **Reading & Phonics:**

\*Ask your child to read their Read, Write, Inc reading book to you.

\*Check their understanding by asking different types of questions. Why do you think....? How do you know....? What would happen if....?

\*Practise the sounds highlighted at the start of the book and ask them to read the green & red words.

### **Writing:**

\*Help your child to practise their Read, Write, Inc phonics by writing a diary, letters to friends/family, short stories, cards, invitations, shopping lists.

## Numeracy



In school, pupils will participate in whole class interactive, teacher led, practical and recorded maths sessions.

### **At home you could:**

\*Count forwards and backwards from different starting points in 1/2/5/10's.

\*Play dice games

\*Learn and continually revise their number facts.

\*Look out for maths learning opportunities in everyday situations eg: car number plates, shopping, house numbers, menus
