You child should know the days of the week and be becoming aware of the months and seasons of the year.

DAYS OF THE WEEK

Monday
Tuesday
Wednesday
Thursday
Friday
Saturday
Sunday

There are 7 days in 1 week
and 14 days in a fortnight
which is the name given to
2 weeks!

MONTHS

January
February
March
April
May
June
July
August
September
October
November
December



There are 12 months in 1
year.

30 days has September, April, June and November.
All the rest have 31
Except February alone,
Which has 28 days clear,
And 29 in each leap year.

SEASONS

Winter - December, January, February
Spring - March, April, May
Summer - June, July August
Autumn - September, October, November



Time

Analogue time is shown on a clock face with moving hands.

The **long hand** on a clock is the **minute** hand.

The **short hand** is the **hour** hand.

In year 3 we focus on the 3 main times below. It is important that your child knows that the **long hand** on a clock is the **minute** hand and the **short hand** is the **hour** hand. There are 60 minutes in an hour.

Digital time is shown using 4 numbers.

O'clock in digital has **00** in the minutes. Eg: 2 o'clock is 2.00

Half past in digital has **30** in the minutes. Eg: half past 5 is 5.30

Quarter past in digital has **15** in the minutes. Eg: quarter past 7 is 7.15
