Reading & Phonics

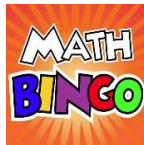
- Ask your child to read their Read, Write, Inc reading book to you.
- Check their understanding by asking different types of questions. Why do you think....? How do you know....? What would happen if....?
- Practise the sounds highlighted at the start of the book and ask them to read the green & red words.
