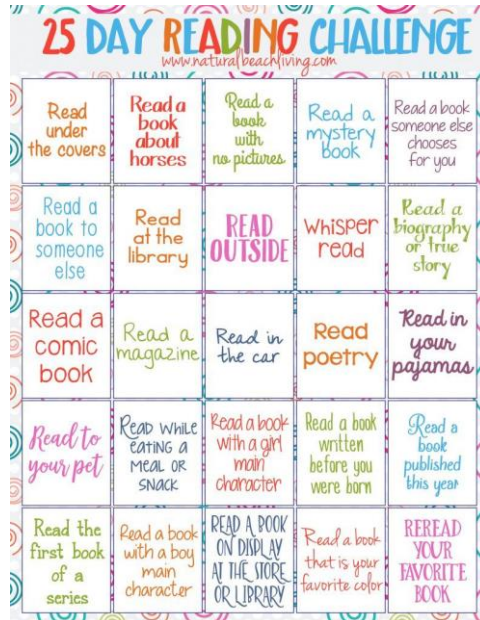
- ✓ Timetables - Have a go at making your own Home School Timetable like Kim's.

❖ **Literacy** - Keep reading daily.

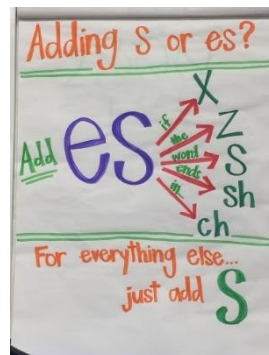
Why not try out a quiz on oxford reading buddy this week if you can or try the reading challenge below?
