Try out the attached **Making Money** and **Coin Count** Challenge



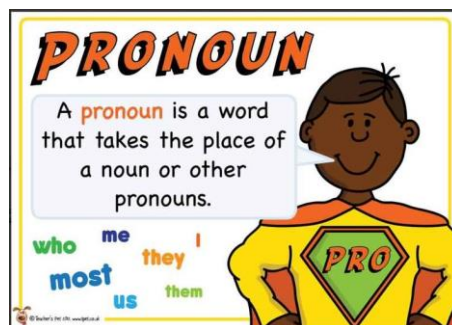

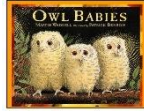

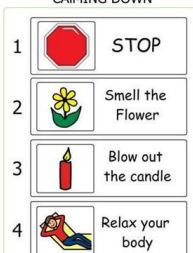
