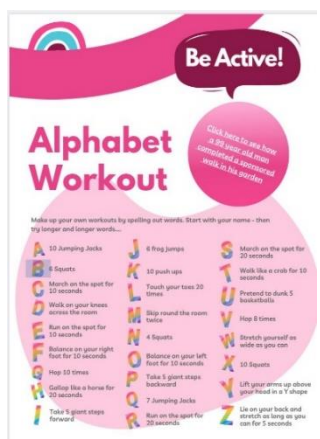
Spelling – List 29



WALT- know the suffix 'al'
A Helpful Tip- If the letter before the suffix is tall or a long letter, then the ending is normally 'le'. If it is a small letter, then the ending is usually 'el' or 'al'.
