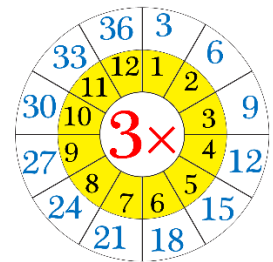

- ✓ Interesting facts about your bird

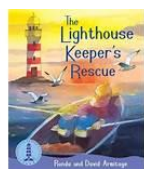
